PART OF SPEECH	DESCRIPTION	EXAMPLES
Noun	A person, place or thing	Boat, umbrella, heart, car
Verb	A word which describes an action	Walk, talk, eat, shout, run
Adjective	A word that describes a noun. It tells you something about the noun.	Tiny, orange, wonderful, cool
Adverb	A word that usually describes a verb. It tells you how something is done. (Words that end in "ly" are usually a good start.)	Slowly, softly, quickly
Interjection	A word that shows emotion or excitement. A stand alone word.	Ouch, hey, yikes, wow
